



Mauritius Wedding Fact Sheet

With a choice of romantic hotels in Mauritius we have the perfect location for your wedding. We will endeavour to do our utmost best to request that only your wedding will take place on your chosen day. You will enjoy the services of an expert wedding co-ordinator here in the UK and a dedicated co-ordinator in Mauritius too.

Minimum Age

To marry in Mauritius you must be 18 years of age or over.

Wedding documents

For either a civil wedding or a religious wedding ceremony in Mauritius we require copies of the following documents from you at least 8 weeks before departure from the uk:

- * **Copies of 10 year passports, valid for at least 6 months after return date**
- * **Copies of birth certificates**
- * **Decree absolute (if divorced)**
- * **Deed poll (if name has changed)**
- * **Death certificate and previous marriage certificate if widowed**
- * **Non english documentation must be translated into english and duly stamped**
- * **One signed copy of the wedding application form which we will send out to you at time of booking**

Weddings can be completed Monday to Friday only (excluding public bank holidays).

Please note we'll need over a month in advance to plan your wedding as we are required to supply the supreme court at least one months notice.

It will be necessary for all couples to swear an affidavit in Port Louis before being married (this may include a decision on your part on how to share all your possessions).

We also suggest that you are in mauritius for at least 3 days before your wedding day.

Wedding Outfits

Your wedding outfits will take up part of your luggage allowance, the airlines unfortunately will not give you extra luggage allowance for your wedding outfits.

We therefore strongly recommend that you have your dress professionally boxed and marked "fragile" if your wedding outfits are going to be placed in the hold of the aircraft.

When in mauritius

- * You'll choose your wedding location – you may complete your wedding any where in the hotel resort, most people decide on the beach or in the lush gardens
- * Most weddings will take place in the afternoons around 3pm - 4pm when the weather is cooler and the light is better for photographs as you can take advantage of the amazing sunsets
- * Two witnesses will be required at your wedding, the hotel will happily provide witnesses if necessary
- * Subject to room availability a room will be made available for the groom to change in

- * Brides flowers/buttonholes
- * Table displays
- * Book live musicians (if preferred you can bring your own cd with your favourite song)
